PARTICIPANTS NEEDED

Buddy Creech, MD, MPH, Assistant Professor, Pediatric Infectious Diseases
and colleagues at Vanderbilt are conducting a randomized,
placebo controlled clinical trial for children with skin infections.

The study focuses on children with small abscesses (less than 3-5 cm depending on age)
and will compare the efficacy of treatment with clindamycin, bactrim, or placebo following
drainage of the abscess. Physicians seeing children with small, drainable abscesses are encouraged
to contact the study team if the family is interested in participating in such a trial.

Since prior antibiotic exposure excludes them from the study, early involvement is critical.
